14 Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ **Alpine Income Property Trust, Inc. (the "Company") is organized and operates as a real estate investment trust ("REIT") as determined under Section 856(a). The Company made quarterly distributions to its shareholders as required by Section 857(a)(1). The total distributions of cash made by the Company to its shareholders exceeded the amount of its current year and accumulated Earnings and Profits determined in accordance with Section 312, as modified by Section 857(d). The excess amount of these distributions is treated as a return of capital to its shareholders. As such, the shareholders are required to reduce their tax basis in their stock as per Section 301(c)(2). The dates for the basis reduction are shown on the attached schedule.**

15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ **The Company, a publicly traded REIT, paid quarterly distributions to the shareholders during the year ended December 31, 2020. In January 2021, the Company determined that a portion of the distributions paid represented a return of capital. The percentage of the return of capital will be reported to the shareholders via Form 1099-DIV. - See attached schedule for details of quarterly distribution payments.**

16 Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ **The calculation for the return of capital portion of the distributions that reduced the tax basis of the stock of the Company shareholders during 2020 was determined based on the total amount of distributions less the amount of the corporation's current Earnings and Profits, determined in accordance with Section 312, as modified by Section 857(d).**
